

## Broad How kitchen inventory (updated November 2024)

*This inventory has been compiled so people visiting the house for the first time will be able to check whether we provide equipment they are likely to need for their visit. It doesn't give exact numbers for crockery, cutlery and glassware but don't worry – you'll find there is enough for groups of 14 – 16 people. We try to keep this list as up-to-date as possible, but obviously we can't guarantee complete accuracy as things get broken or misplaced and exact replacements may not be instantly available.*

*In November 2024 we updated this inventory to link it to the plan of the kitchen which you can also download from our website. It was suggested by a visitor that a plan would be useful so that people don't have to look in every drawer or cupboard to find the garlic press when they're trying to cook a meal for 16 people! **The red numbers on this inventory refer to the kitchen plan.** ('Out' means visible on a working surface)*

### The Larder

The larder between the kitchen door and the back door contains various cake and biscuit tins, and a vegetable rack.

### The Old Wash House

Just outside the back door you will find the Old Wash House. As well as the extra fridge/freezer mentioned earlier, you will also find:

- 2x washing machines
- Tumble drier
- Clothes pegs and laundry baskets
- Dog bowls

You will need to supply your own washing powder (non-bio is helpful for our sewage treatment plant).
