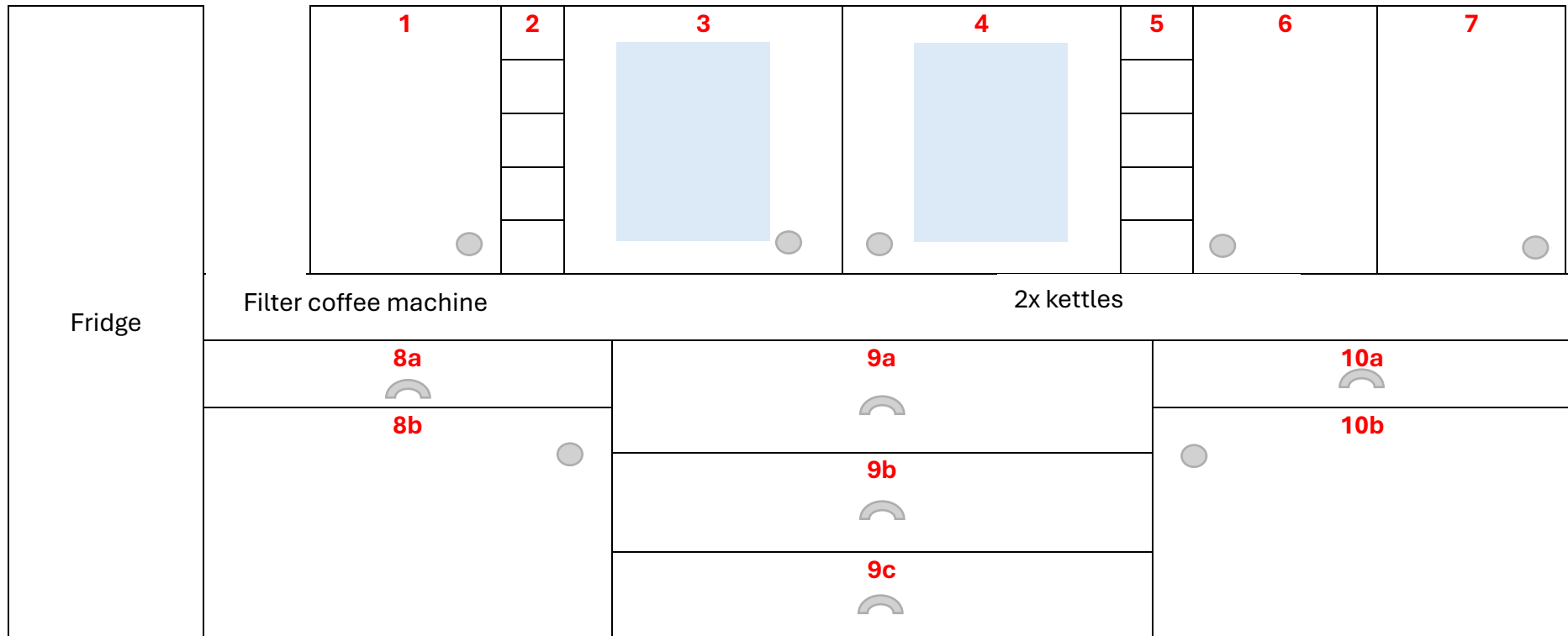


# Kitchen diagram (not to scale)

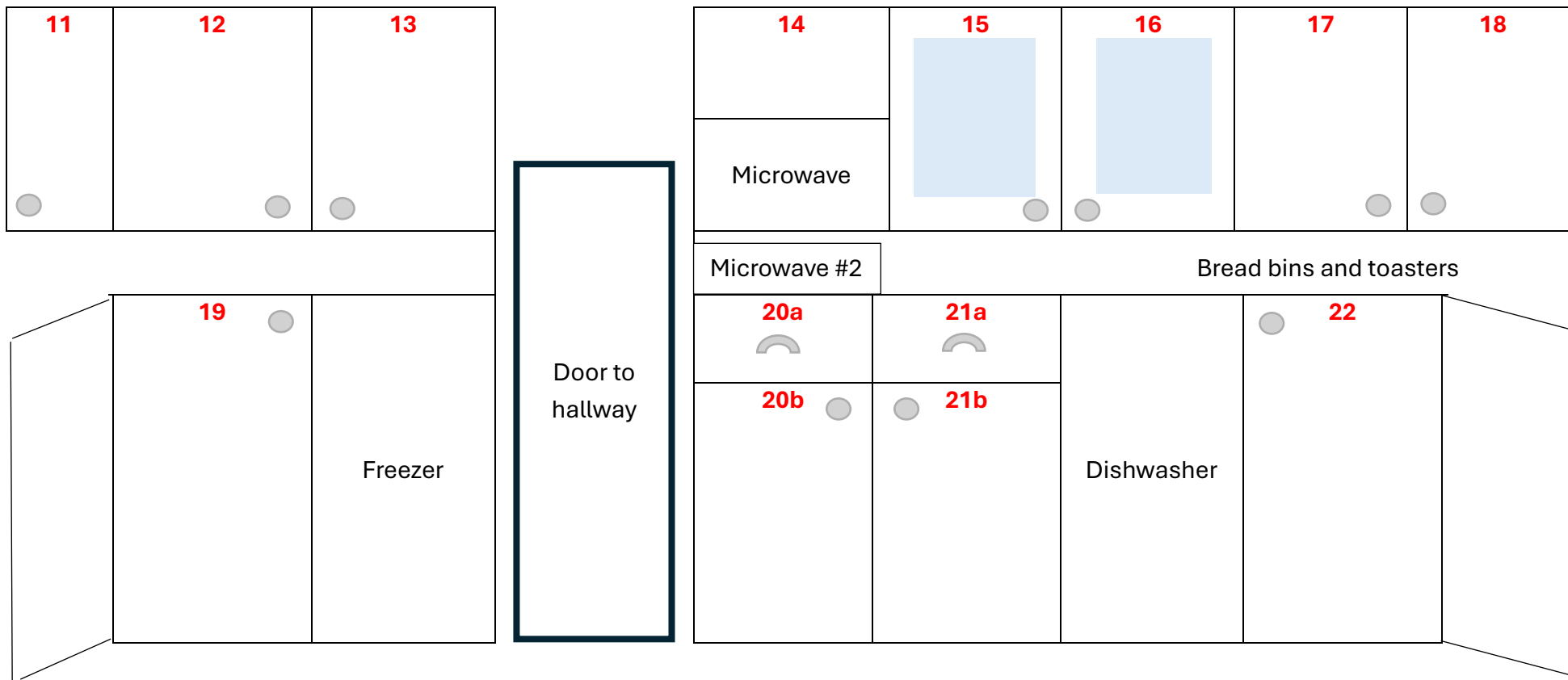
From large fridge to corner

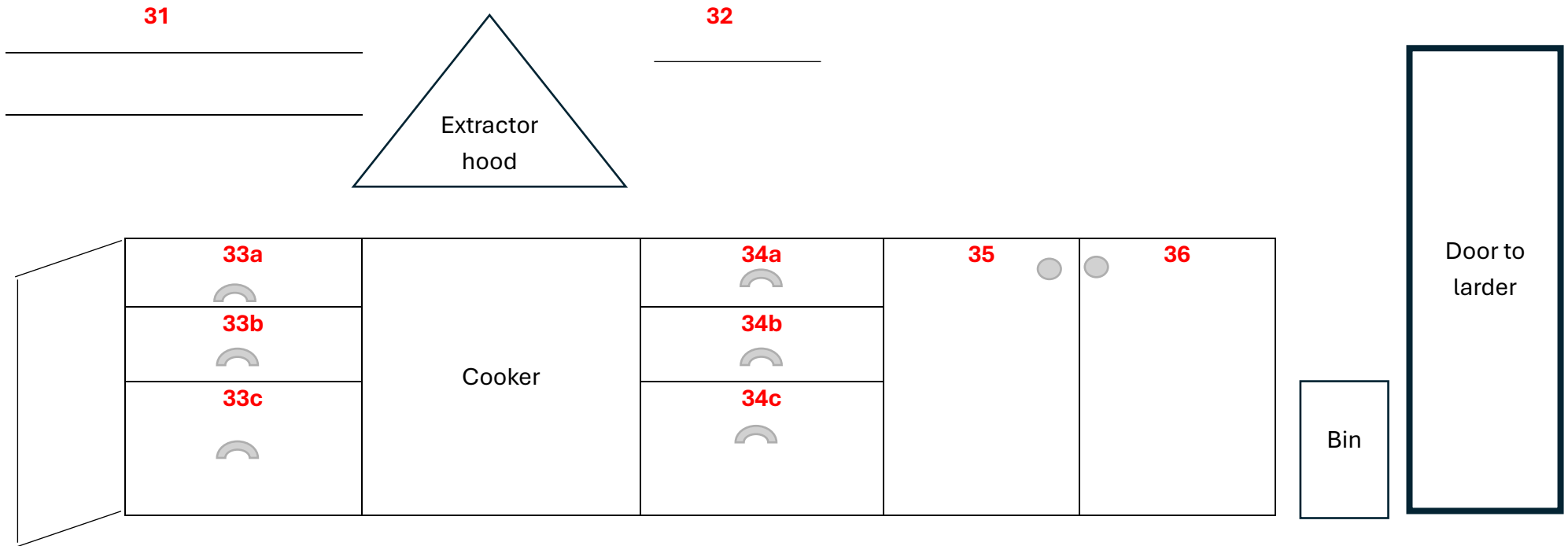
